A positive FIP 7b ELISA titer documents exposure to a strain of coronavirus expressing the 7b protein. Strains of feline coronavirus expressing the 7b protein are reported to be more likely to cause FIP. However, a positive antibody titer is not specific for FIP disease and a negative titer does not exclude the possibility of FIP.
